JOB DESCRIPTION

In partnership with the CEO and Director of Development – Corporate Giving & Major Gifts, the Director of Development – Foundation & Annual Giving helps to provide strategic planning, management, and direction for all annual and foundation fundraising and development activities for the Gallo Center. S/he plays an integral role in helping the team raise more than \$1 million annually. This is a full-time, non-exempt position that includes health and retirement benefits.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Identify, cultivate, and solicit prospective donors in the following programs: Friends of the Center, Amigos of the Center, Legacy Circle, and Duets; as well as various arts education initiatives and memorial/honorarium gifts.
- Drive acquisition, renewals and upgrades through ongoing stewardship activities, an
 effective mail/e-mail renewal campaign, and the accurate and timely fulfillment of all
 committed benefits
- Ensure the highest level of donor satisfaction through timely communication, appropriate recognition, pro-active engagement and clear illustration of the impact associated with donor gifts
- Serve as the primary contact for Friends of the Center and Amigos of the Center donors including processing tickets for performances as needed
- Research grant opportunities, write and submit proposals, and perform all follow-up grant reporting in a timely manner
- Manage the production of all direct mail acquisition campaigns, development newsletters, and all other general department communications
- Oversee and manage a series of fundraising and cultivation events, working closely with development staff and board volunteers
- Oversee donor database, generate development reports, and create unique data lists for development department
- Leverage the Center's donor database (Tessitura) to segment and identify donor prospects
- Work in partnership with the Director of Development Corporate Giving & Major Gifts to create and administer the department budget
- Attend Center-presented performances, as appropriate, for the purpose of cultivating relationships with current donors and networking to meet prospective ones; represent the Center at select community events
- Manage the full-time development coordinator and a core group of department volunteers
